

## Happy Critter Farm Barn Rules

### HELMET & SMOOTH-SOLED, HEELED SHOES HIGHLY ENCOURAGED FOR RIDING

#### Closed toe shoes highly recommended around the barn

1. Keep gates closed, or fastened open. No loose gates!
2. **Please park along the North side of the arena**, unless it's really wet.
3. Dogs permitted with prior permission of STABLE. Dogs must be under control at all times.
4. Keep children under supervision.
5. **Keep tack room door closed, else Abby (big white dog) will find something to chew.**
6. Tack room is for storage of tack only. With permission of STABLE, you may store feed in mouse proof bins in the feed room.
7. **Clean up after your horse: Clear poop from the round pen, arena, barn aisle, and tie areas. Spread manure on the grass, around the trees, add to compost bin, or add to manure pile.**
8. Do not leave a tied or otherwise restrained animal unattended.
9. No loose horses in the barn.
10. If your horse is injured or becomes ill, arrange for proper care of the horse and see that it receives proper medical attention. Pay all medical fees incurred. STABLE shall have no liability therefore.  
If your horse dies, arrange for prompt disposal.
11. Leave a contact number when you are away.
12. Notify STABLE if anyone else is permitted to ride, handle, or otherwise call for your horse(s).
13. Notify STABLE if your horse(s) will be absent for one or more nights.
14. Report breakage or damage immediately to STABLE. You are responsible for the cost of time and materials to repair damage / breakage beyond normal wear and tear. Repeated damage may result in a request to vacate.
15. Submit all construction/installation requests to STABLE. You may not make any physical changes to the facility without prior approval. All improvements become property of STABLE.
16. An OWNER whose horse cribs or chews wood is required to manage the cribbing with spray and/or cribbing collars as indicated by the severity of the cribbing, to be determined by STABLE. If the cribbing is unmanageable, the OWNER may be asked to remove the horse.
